Regulation (EU) 2025/40 – Compliance with the EU Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (PPWR) - Declaration dated 13 July 2026

Dear Sir or Madam,

With this letter, we confirm our compliance with the requirements of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 concerning packaging in the B2B sector.

We use only standard packaging materials sourced from qualified suppliers. The packaging used for your products has already been optimized with regard to recyclability and the appropriate use of materials. In addition, we have assessed and selected the packaging materials for conformity with the requirements of Regulation (EU) 2025/40.

In particular, this includes:

- Packaging that does not contain substances exceeding the limits specified in the Regulation
- Cardboard packaging with an already high, industry-standard recycled content
- Packaging with an optimal balance between material usage and protective performance
- Packaging materials consisting of single-material components, enabling a high degree of reuse and recyclability at our customers' facilities
- Expanded polystyrene (EPS) packaging for which material recycling has been established

Relevant supplier declarations regarding material data sheets, declarations of conformity, information on recyclability, and details of substances contained in the packaging materials are available or are being obtained on an ongoing basis.

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The European Commission will still define so-called delegated acts and implementing acts for many individual aspects of Regulation (EU) 2025/40. These are expected to be published in due time before the respective obligations become applicable. As a result, early and detailed implementation and assessment remain particularly challenging at present, especially with regard to the following obligations that will only apply at a later stage:

- Recyclability requirements in accordance with Article 6 (from 2030)
- Minimum recycled content requirements and compostability requirements in accordance with Articles 7 and 9 (from 2030 and 2028 respectively)
- Packaging prevention requirements in accordance with Articles 10 and 24 (from 12 February 2028 at the earliest)
- Labelling requirements in accordance with Article 12 (from 12 August 2028)
- Reuse requirements in accordance with Article 11 and Articles 26 to 29 et seq. (more specifically from 2030 onwards)

On this basis, our business partners are currently, in most cases, not yet able to provide complete information regarding the above-mentioned requirements. Consequently, we are only able to pass on the information currently available to us.

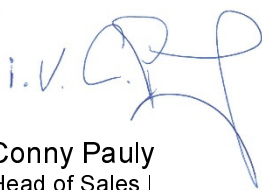
